Reading: We focused on point of view and distinguishing our own point of view from that of the author.

Writing: Students wrote letters from the point of view of a pumpkin, trying to persuade their reader to not pick them from the pumpkin patch.

Grammar: We learned about plural nouns.

Math: We began Unit 3: Multi-Digit Addition & Subtraction. This week we focused on rounding to the nearest ten and rounding to the nearest hundred.

Social Studies: We continued learning about the three branches of government: Legislative, Judicial, and Executive. Students are working in teams to research one branch of government and then create a presentation of their choice to share with the class.
